



The John Grube Foundation e.V., based in Hamburg, awards the "John Grube Prize" in honour of its namesake, who died young of granulomatosis with polyangiitis (GPA). Since 2021, the DGRh has been involved in the award by sending a member of the board to the advisory board of the foundation and by providing a platform and a dignified setting for the award with the German Rheumatology Congress. The John Grube Prize honours research work that makes a significant contribution to the understanding and treatment of ANCA-associated vasculitides. It is endowed with 15,000 euros. The prize was announced for the first time in 2021.

John Grube died in 2017 as a result of an unusually severe episode of granulomatosis with polyangiitis (GPA). A few months later, relatives and friends founded the John Grube Foundation e.V. to promote research, better information and more extensive support for patients and their relatives.

- a publication on ANCA-associated vasculitis
- a short, conclusive summary of the research work and results
- a current curriculum vitae
